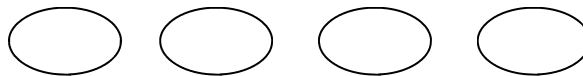
Here are this week's challenges:

### Juniors: Duck Ponds

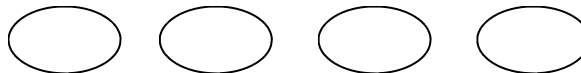


Use 14 ducks each time.

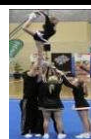
